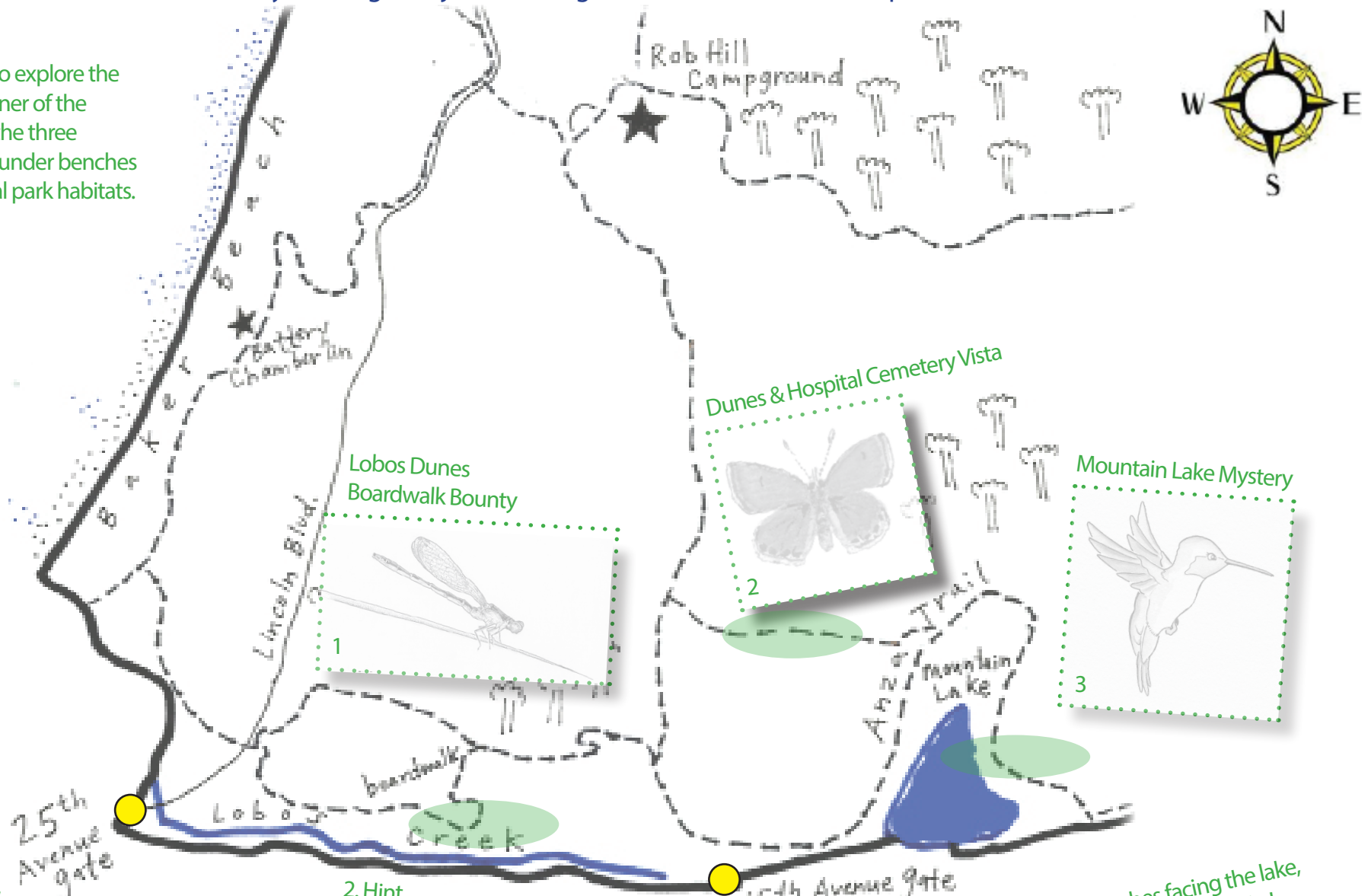


Hello Presidio explorers!
